Families with children will be especially delighted with this new ticket, since all three peaks offer family-friendly facilities, e.g. free all-terrain prams on the Zwieselalm, paths which are suitable for infants on the Feuerkogel and wheelchair access on the Krippenstein!

With the **3 Gipfelticket** you can get up the mountain in comfort, then back into the valley again, on the Feuerkogel, Zwieselalm and Dachstein Salzkammergut. The Feuerkogel, Upper Austria's most sun blessed point, with its fantastic 360 degree panoramic view to Dachstein and the lakes region, cosy Alpine lodges and its many sporting activities on offer, invites you to have an unforgettable experience in the heart of the Salzkammergut! The route from Ebensee at Traunsee up to 1600 metres altitude into the heart of the adventure-filled mountain village is very well accessible via the Feuerkogel cable car.

An excursion to the Alberfeldkogel viewing platform and the impressive Europakreuz, which is around an hour's walk away, is just one of the many hiking options providing superb views, as you might expect on Upper Austria's most beautiful and most sunny Alpine plateau.

From Gosausee lake to the most beautiful Glacier view

The Gosaukammbahn opens up Alpine expanses to hikers, athletes and walkers, where the Salzkammergut is at its loveliest. From Gosausee the gondola glides toward the unusual crags of the Gosaukamm, taking guests into a realm of inviting Alpine lodges and hiking routes which provide plenty of variety. Experienced, passionate hikers are happy here, as too are

those who walk at a more leisurely pace, and those who really enjoy stopping off in an Alpine lodge. On the best signposted hiking routes cross Alpine meadows, you get to hike through dark mountain forests, where you can keep going for two to three hours, or even for several days at time.

The really fit might opt for the challenging Intersport fixed rope route on the Donnerkogel! And inviting Alpine lodges for miles around invite you to stop off and sample some regional delicacies!

Wonderful hiking tips:

- From the mountain station for the Gosaukammbahn down to Gosausee lake 1 hour
- Descent to Gosau-Hintertal 1.5 hours
- Zwieselalmhöhe circuit, "Jägerweg" (Hunter's Path) 2 hours
- Großer Donnerkogel 3 hours
- To Stuhlalm and Körnerhütte, with return journey 3 hours
- Via Herrenweg in the town of Gosau 3 hours

The wheelchair accessible panorama gondola takes guests in comfort to the Dachstein mountain world at over 2000 m altitude, where the views are superb. Breathtaking viewing platforms such as those on the 5 fingers and the Welterbe-Spirale are available, as is a perfectly accessible network of hiking paths for families and nature lovers.

The three big Dachstein caves – Eishöhle, Mammuthöhle and Koppenbrüllerhöhle – take you into a secret underground realm, shaped and created from water and ice. Unique lighting and sounds provide a stylish setting for this hidden world. The new guided tour for children “Korah and the cave bear” and trekking tours of various difficulty levels provide inspiration, and exciting adventures inside the mountains.

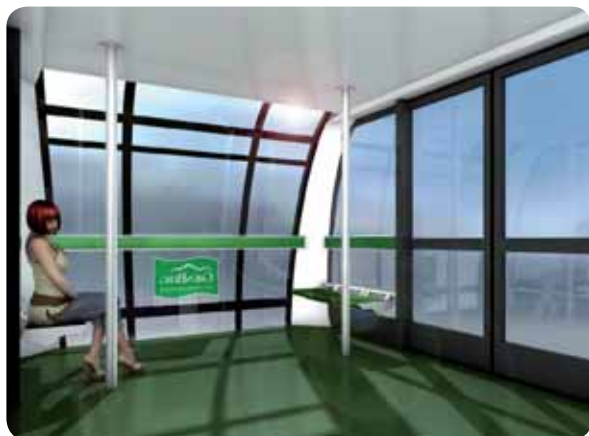
